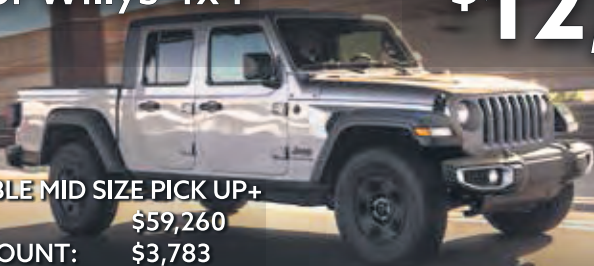

Oh deer! Hunters can share their harvest

The state Department of Agriculture and Pennsylvania Game Commission are again encouraging hunters to consider sharing their deer harvest to provide thousands of pounds of venison to people in need.

Hunters Sharing the Harvest (HSH) is Pennsylvania's venison donation program for hunters who share their extra venison via a statewide network of participating butchers to food pantries and community assistance centers across the Commonwealth. One deer provides about 200 servings of high-protein, low-fat venison. Thanks to the program's generous supporters, hunters pay nothing to ensure their venison helps to provide a warm meal to someone in need in their

community.

Some surprising benefits of blueberries

Furthermore, the high amounts of vitamin C in blueberries also can inhibit the growth of bacteria that cause UTIs.

**4. Blueberries may thwart cancer.** Phytochemicals in blueberries decrease the risk of several cancers by protecting cells from chronic inflammation, according to the American Institute for Cancer Research. In addition, the fiber in blueberries helps protect the intestinal lining from colorectal cancer.

**5. Blueberries help build stronger bones.** Blueberries are rich in phosphorus, zinc, magnesium, calcium, iron, and vitamin K. These nutrients, together with strength-training exercise, can contribute to bone health.

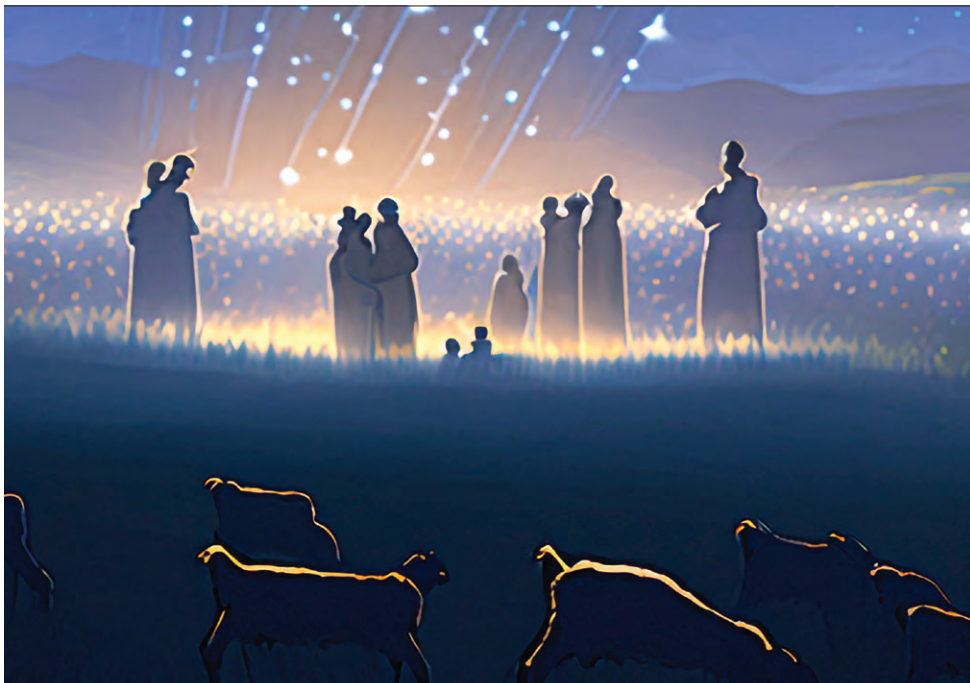

# Tips for safer winter generator usage

Winter will be here soon, and if your electricity goes out due to snow and ice, a generator can keep power flowing to your home or business. The Outdoor Power Equipment Institute (OPEI), an international trade association representing manufacturers and suppliers of outdoor power equipment, small engines, battery power systems, portable generators, utility and personal transport vehicles, and golf cars, reminds home and business owners to keep safety in mind when using generators this winter.

“Not having power when you need it is frustrating, so a generator can provide emergency backup power at a reasonable cost,” says Kris Kiser, President and CEO of OPEI. “It’s important to follow all manufacturer’s instructions, and never place a generator in your garage or inside your home or building. It should be a safe distance from the structure and not near an air intake.”

More tips include:

- **Take stock of your generator.** Make sure equipment is in good working order before starting and using it. Do this before a storm hits.
- **Review the directions.** Follow all manufacturer’s instructions. Review the owner’s manuals (look manuals up online if you cannot find them) so equipment is operated safely.
- **Install a battery operated carbon monoxide detector in your home.** This alarm will sound if dangerous levels of carbon monoxide enter the building.

• **Have the right fuel on hand.** Use the type of fuel recommended by the generator manufacturer to protect this important investment. It is illegal to use any fuel with more than 10% ethanol in outdoor power equipment. (For more information on proper fueling for outdoor power equipment visit [www.LookBeforeYouPump.com](http://www.LookBeforeYouPump.com)). It’s best to use fresh fuel, but if you are using fuel that has been sitting in a gas can for more than thirty days, add fuel stabilizer to it. Store gas only in an approved container and away from heat sources.

• **Ensure portable generators have plenty of ventilation.** Generators should NEVER be used in an enclosed area or placed inside a home, a building, or a garage.

rage, even if the windows or doors are open. Place the generator outside and away from windows, doors, and vents that could allow carbon monoxide to drift indoors.

• **Keep the generator dry.** Do not use a generator in wet conditions. Cover and vent a generator. Model-specific tents or generator covers can be found online for purchase and at home centers and hardware stores.

**WAGNER** – Warren N. Wagner, 98, passed away December 13, 2023. He was the widower of Geraldine J. Hetrick Wagner.

• **Only add fuel to a cool generator.** Before refueling, turn the generator off and let it cool down.

• **Charge & use battery-powered generators/inverters properly.** Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may not be compatible with another battery pack. Follow all charging instructions and do not charge the battery pack or equipment outside the temperature range specified in the instructions. Charging improperly or at temperatures outside the specified range may damage the battery.

• **Plug in safely.** If you don't yet have a transfer switch, you can use the outlets on the generator. It's best to plug in appliances directly to the generator. If you must use an extension cord, it should be heavy-duty and designed for outdoor use. It should be rated (in watts or amps) at least equal to the sum of the connected appliance loads. Make sure the cord is free of cuts, and the plug has all three prongs.

• **Install a transfer switch.** A transfer switch connects the generator to the circuit panel and lets you power hardwired appliances. Most transfer switches also help avoid overload by displaying wattage usage levels.

• **Do not use the generator to “backfeed” power into your home electrical system.** Trying to power your home's electrical wiring by “backfeeding” – where you plug the generator into a wall outlet – is dangerous. You could hurt utility workers and neighbors served by the same transformer. Backfeeding bypasses built-in circuit protection devices, so you could damage your electronics or start an electrical fire.

PA residents warned of a new scam

Pennsylvania Treasurer Stacy Garrity is warning residents of a new scam involving false promises of a state grant and fraudulent requests to pay taxes using gift cards.

In this scam, unsuspecting residents receive a call, an email and/or a letter claiming to be from the Pennsylvania Treasury Department or the Federal Reserve Bank, fraudulently indicating the recipient will be awarded grant money but first must pay taxes. In at least one case, the recipient was told to make the supposed tax payments with gift cards.

Treasury does not announce grant awards, and it does not collect taxes. In addition, Treasury will never request a payment be made with a gift card, and neither will any other legitimate government agency.

In one case, an elderly Indiana County resident was initially contacted by telephone and told he would receive a \$25,500 grant from the state but had to pay thousands of dollars in taxes first, using gift cards. He purchased the cards, called the scammer back and provided the information needed to access the gift cards. This happened multiple times.

Treasury has provided information about this scam to the appropriate law enforcement agencies.

Anyone who believes they have been the victim of a scam or attempted scam should immediately report it to the Federal Trade Commission, the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General and their local law enforcement agency.

If you or anyone you know has received suspicious correspondence claiming to be from the Pennsylvania Treasury Department, please contact Treasury here, or by calling 717-787-2465.

Dog owners reminded to license pets for 2024

All dogs three months of age and older are required to be licensed by Jan. 1 of each year. Dog owners may choose to purchase single-year licenses or a lifetime license, if their dog has some form of permanent identification, such as a microchip or tattoo.

Single-year licenses cost \$6.70 for altered animals and \$8.70 for unaltered animals. Lifetime licenses cost \$31.70 for altered animals and \$51.70 for an unaltered animal.

Please note that license fees will be increasing effective Feb. 1.

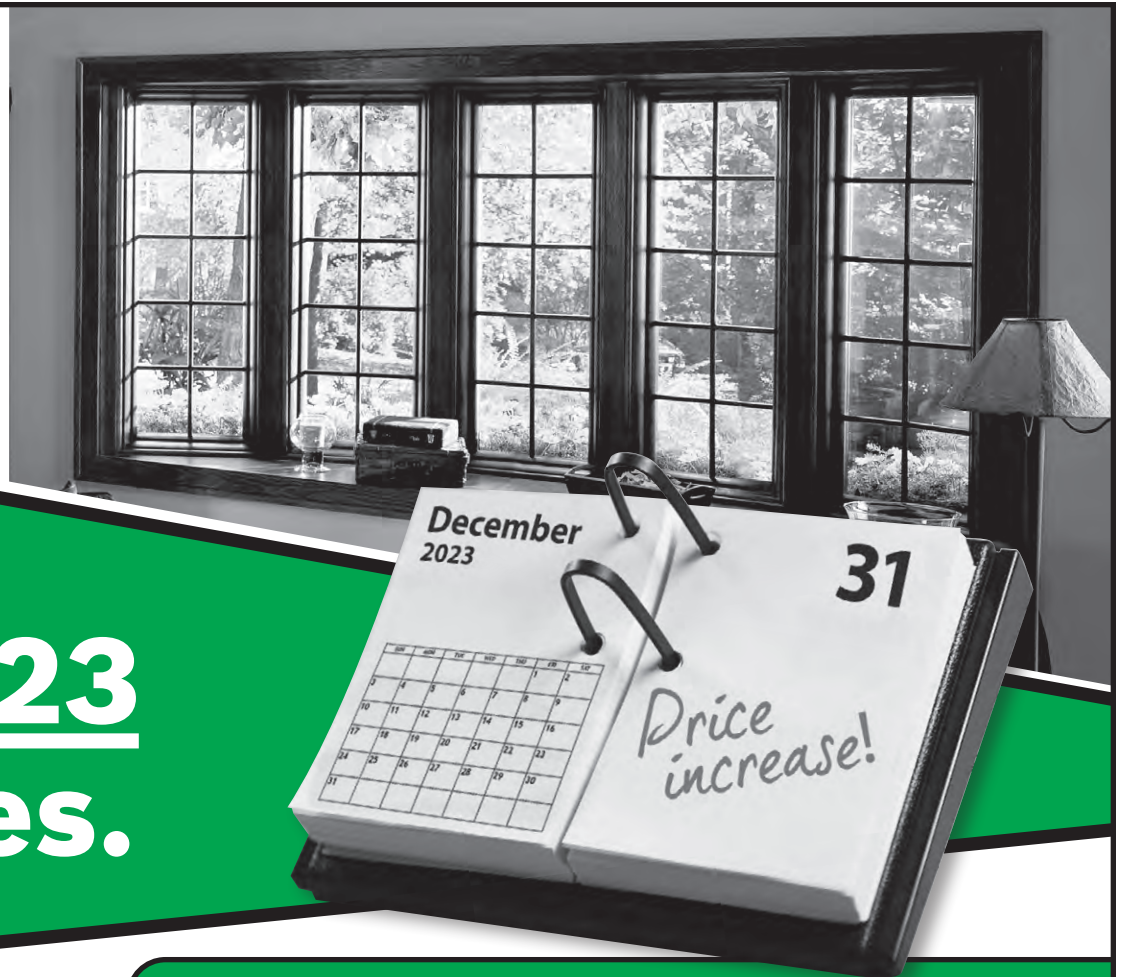
