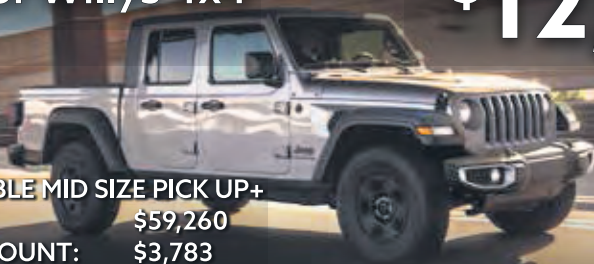

is pleased to announce its 1st annual Student Video Contest.

Lancaster-Lebanon County high school students are invited to create 60-90-second videos that demonstrate the theme, "Make a Game Plan to Vote!" The League wants voters to know that democracy is not a spectator sport and that no one should sit on the sidelines in an election.

Videos can be live, live action or animated and MUST be NONPARTISAN. Full rules and details can be found on the website <https://www.lwvlancaster.org/vid-co-contest>

Entries are due by February 8, 2024. Videos will be evaluated on a scale of one to ten for each of the following three criteria:

1) Clear and Compelling

Message,

2) Memorable Content and Delivery, and

3) Originality.

Prizes will be awarded, with first place winning \$300, second place \$150, and third place \$75. Winners will be announced at a screening on March 8, 2024 at the annual International Women's Day celebration at Zoetropolis.

JANUARY 2023

Pennsylvania Farm Show - The 107th installment of the Pennsylvania Farm Show opened this year with nearly 4,000 animals, 12,000-plus competitive events, 245 commercial exhibits and hundreds of educational and entertaining events.

Meteorologist Hall of Fame - The Punxsutawney Weather Discovery Center inducted Punxsutawney Phil into the Meteorologist Hall of Fame. "Phil" will be the final and most famous inductee into the Meteorologist Hall of Fame. "Phil" began his weather forecasting in 1887 on Gobbler's Knob in Punxsutawney, Pa. and over the years has inspired songs, poetry and cinema.

New Lebanon Police Chief, Captain Announced - Mayor Capello announced the promotion of former Captain Bret Fisher, as Chief of the Lebanon City Police Department and former Lt. Eric Sims as the new police captain. Some of the new leadership goals include more community outreach and filling department ranks.

Lebanon Hosts Statewide Fire Chiefs - Statewide fire chiefs convened in Lebanon for a three-day conference to learn, discuss legislation and network at city sites. Lebanon City Fire Department's latest apparatus, BEST, was the star of the event. Lebanon was the first fire company in Pennsylvania to buy Battery Extinguish System Technology (BEST) which is used to fight electric vehicle fires.

FEBRUARY 2023

Boeing Delivers Last Jumbo Jet - The Boeing Company bid farewell to its iconic 747 jumbo jet. The final plane is the 1,574th built by Boeing and was delivered to Atlas Air. For the future Boeing and rival manufacturers of jets are producing more profitable and fuel efficient wide-body planes.

Furry Forecaster - Punxsutawney Phil emerged from his burrow and saw his shadow. He predicts there will be 6 more weeks of winter.

Civil War Artillery Shell Found at Gettysburg - An unexploded Civil War artillery shell was found at Gettysburg National Military Park. The ordinance was found on the battlefield near Little Round Top and dates back to the Battle of Gettysburg

July 1-3, 1863. The 55th Ordinance Disposal Company team from Fort Belvoir, Virginia safely removed the shell and destroyed it.

Thousands of Migrating Geese Return to Middle Creek - The annual migration of snow geese, tundra swans and Canadian geese begins. The 6,254-acre Pennsylvania Game Commission property has a 400-acre lake and hosts numbers of geese estimated at higher than 100,000 birds.

American Red Cross Volunteers Retire - Paul and Mary Ann LeVan served the Lebanon Valley for nearly six decades as volunteers of the American Red Cross. Together the couple has 108 years of volunteer service to the local community. The LeVans were recognized with a retirement party and a special commendation from Lebanon Mayor Sherry Capello.

Cedar Crest Grad Nominated for Grammy Award in Album Packaging - 1997 Cedar Crest High School graduate Will Stichter was nominated as art director for Best Recording Packaging for "Divers" the album he and longtime friend Matt Stone, a Mount Gretna native, released last year by their ambient/experimental band Sopor.

Lebanon Area Native to Release First Album - Olivia Farabaugh, a 2013 graduate of Palmyra Area High School, singer and song writer, releases her first full-length CD in Nashville, Tennessee. Olivia was a regular performer on stage at the Lebanon Area Fair, competed on "The Voice" and at the Pentagon. Her big goal is to perform someday at the Grand Ole Opry.

Hollywood Sex Symbol Dies - Raquel Welch, 82, died after a brief illness. Raquel Welch emerged from the sea in a skimpy, furry bikini in the film "One Million Years B.C." and was propelled to international sex-symbol status throughout the 1960's and 70's. In addition to acting Welch was a singer and dancer. She won a Golden Glob for her part in "The Three Musketeers" and a nomination for the TV movie "Right to Die".

Lebanon Valley Rail Trail - The Lebanon Valley Rail Trail broke ground on Phases 6A and 6B, a new section of the trail that, when finished, will feature approximately two miles of mixed-use trail and a new city park. The John E. Wengert Memorial Park will be located on Chestnut Street.

MARCH 2023

Hershey Plant-Based Candies Debut - The Hershey Co. announced that Reese's Plant-based Peanut Butter Cups will be its first vegan chocolates sold nationally. A second offering will be Hershey's Plant Based Extra Creamy with Almonds and Sea Salt. Both chocolates are made with oats instead of milk.

Lebanon County 4-H Member Earns Top State Achievement - Jolene Bomgardner, a native of North Lebanon Township and a Lebanon County 4-H Friends Club member, received the Diamond Clover Award, the highest achievement possible in the Pennsylvania 4-H program. The Clover Award Program prompts 4-H members to pursue projects that help them acquire seven fundamental leadership skills: communicating, decision making and problem solving, getting along with others, learning to learn, managing, understanding self, and working in groups. Being recognized with the honor is typically a multi-year process and requires planning and implementing a service-learning project in the community.

Local Pastry Chef Receives Award - Lebanon County Career & Technology Center pastry chef instructor Brian Peffley was named the 2023 Pennsylvania ProStart Educator of the Year. The award is presented annually to recognize culinary arts educators who demonstrate excellence in the classroom, along with passion, commitment and creativity in all aspects of the ProStart program. This program is offered by the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation.

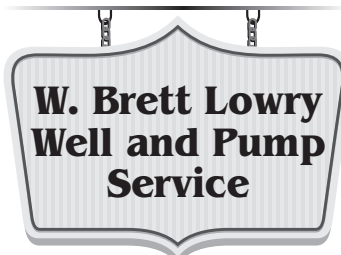

Stay Awake on the Road

Fatigue on the road can be a killer, especially on the open highway at night. Many refer to it as "highway hypnosis," when the road seems never to end and it starts to lure you into a far-off gaze. These tips should help prevent you from nodding off before you find a place to pull over

safely:

- **Get enough rest.** Never start a trip late in the day. Long-distance driving is tough. You need to be ready and awake.
- **If possible, don't drive alone.** Passengers can take turns driving, talking to each other, and keeping each other awake if neces-

sary.

- **Adjust your car's environment so that it helps keep you awake and alert.** In the summer, keep the temperature cool with open windows or air conditioning. Be frugal with heat in the winter.
- **Watch your posture.** Drive with your head up

and your shoulders back. Tuck your buttocks against the seat back. Legs should not be fully extended, but flexed at about a 45-degree angle.

- **Take frequent breaks.** Stretch. Move around. Don't get back in your car until you feel awake and alert.

Sunshine Crepes

- 2 Large Eggs (room temperature)
- 2/3 Cup 2% Milk
- 1 Tablespoon Canola Oil
- 1/2 Cup All-purpose Flour
- 1 Teaspoon Sugar
- 1/4 Teaspoon Salt

Filling

1 Can (20 oz.) crushed pineapple (drained)

1 Can (11 oz.) Mandarin oranges (drained)

1 Teaspoon Vanilla Extract

1 carton (8 oz.) Frozen Whipped Topping (thawed)

Confectioner's Sugar

In a large bowl, whisk eggs, milk and oil. In another bowl, mix flour, sugar, and salt; add to egg mixture and mix well. Refrigerate, covered, one hour.

Heat a lightly greased 8-in. nonstick skillet over medium heat. Stir batter. Fill a 1/4 cup measure halfway with batter; pour into center of pan. Quickly lift and tilt pan to coat bottom evenly. Cook until top appears dry; turn crepe over and cook until bottom is cooked, 15-20 seconds longer. Remove to a wire rack. Repeat with remaining batter, greasing pan as needed. When cool, stack crepes between pieces of waxed paper or paper towels.

For filling, in a large bowl, combine pineapple, oranges, and vanilla; fold in whipped topping. Spread 1/3 cup over each crepe; fold into quarters. Dust with confectioner's sugar.

Strawberry

Banana Crepes

- 1 Cup All-Purpose Flour
- 1 Tablespoon Sugar
- 1/2 Teasoon Ground Cinnamon
- 1 1/2 Cups Milk
- 2 Large Eggs
- 1 to 2 Tablespoons Butter

Filling

1 package (8 oz.) Cream Cheese (softened)

1 carton (8 oz.) Frozen Whipped Topping (thawed)

1/2 Cup Confectioner's Sugar

Topping

2 Cups Sliced Strawberries

2 medium firm bananas (sliced)

1/4 Cup Sugar (optional)

In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar, cinnamon, milk, and eggs. Cover and refrigerate for one hour.

In an 8-inch nonstick skillet, melt 1 teaspoon butter. Stir batter; pour about two tablespoons into the center of the skillet. Lift and tilt pan to evenly coat bottom. Cook until top appears dry; turn and cook 15-20 seconds longer. Remove to a wire rack.

Repeat with remaining batter, add butter to skillet as needed. When cool, stack crepes on paper towels with waxed paper in between.

In a large bowl, beat the filling ingredients until smooth. Spread two rounded tablespoons on each crepe; roll up. In a large bowl, combine topping ingredients; spoon with crepes.

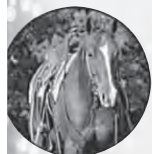

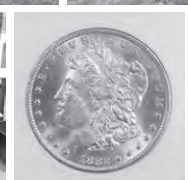

During apheresis, a cell separator is used to collect platelets or other components from blood that is drawn from the donor. The remaining components are then returned to the donor during the donation process. As many as 24 apheresis donations can be made in a single year, though the apheresis donation process, which can last as long as two hours, takes longer than a typical blood donation.

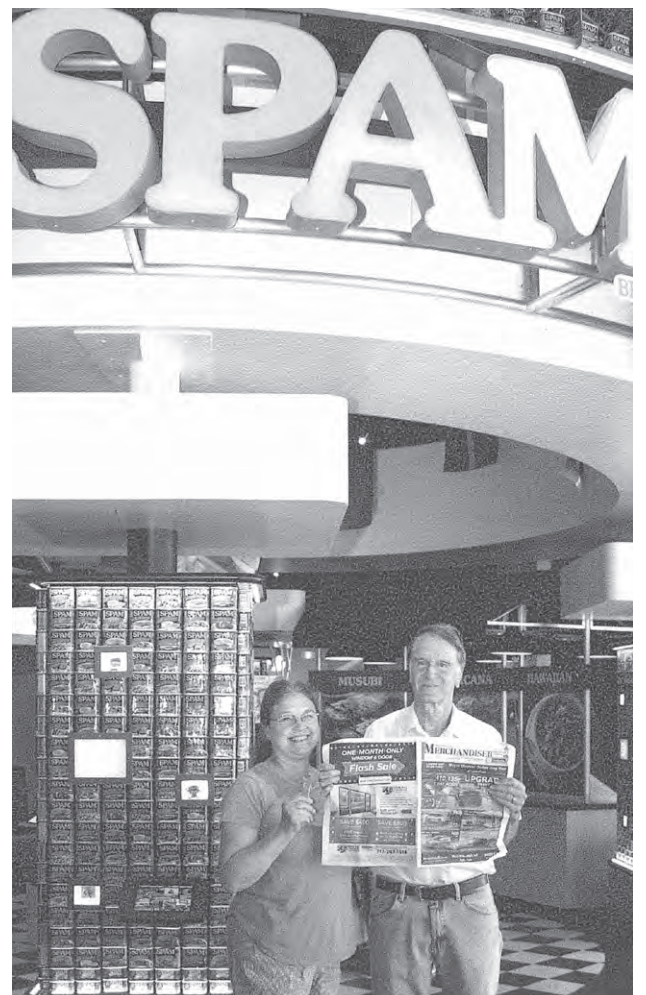

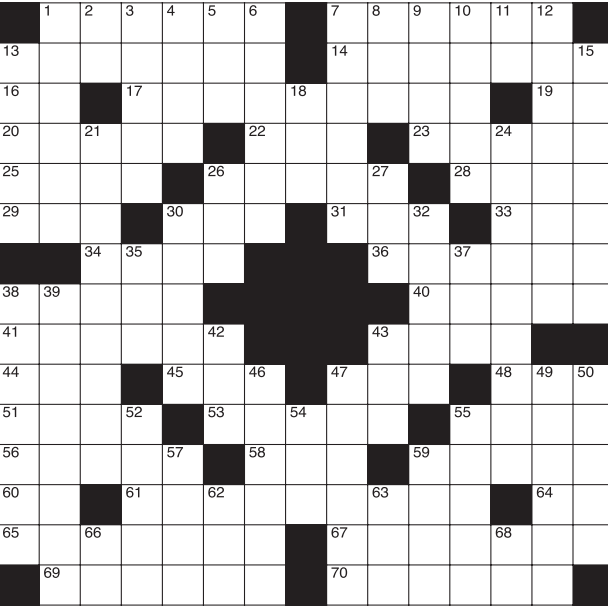
